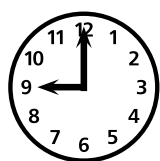

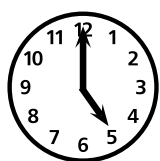

- Who live in or are from the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham

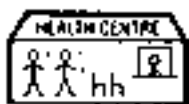
We can help you:



make choices



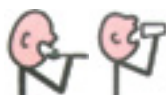
be healthy

be more independent



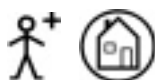
have a Health Action Plan

take short breaks for you and your carer(s)

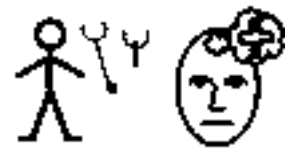
