



Burglary is a serious issue; that's why the Council and the police are working hard at targeting burglars and to reduce burglaries.

You can help us keep your home and property secure by following our security checklist:

- Close and lock all windows and doors, even if you are only going out for a few minutes
- Keep your valuables out of sight
- Fit a mortice lock to your front door and other external doors and window locks – and use them
- Do not leave your house or car keys near a door, letterbox or window
- Fit a letterbox cage to the back of your front door
- Make sure you have up to date contents insurance
- Do not leave ladders out which would allow access to higher windows
- Mark or etch your property with your postcode, house of flat number
- Register items with serial number at **[www.immobilise.com](http://www.immobilise.com)**
- Leave some lights on if it will be dark before you get home.
